A non-refundable deposit is required at time of enrollment, \$25 deposit per weekly enrollment and/or \$10 deposit per daily enrollment. A weekly draft option is available for the remaining balance. The remaining balance is due the Wednesday prior to the week that your child attends camp. We offer a 2nd child discount of \$10/week for weekly camp enrollments, please note there is not a 2nd child discount available for daily rates.
