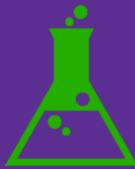

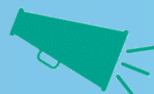

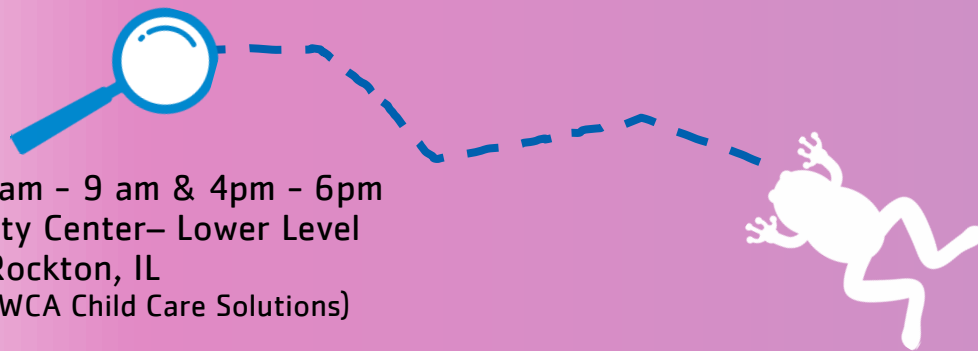

CAMP FEES

Fees include camp activities, extended care (6 am–9 am and 4 pm–6 pm), swimming, field trips, and AM and PM snacks. A non-refundable deposit is required at time of enrollment, \$25 deposit per weekly enrollment and/or \$10 deposit per daily enrollment. A weekly draft option is available for the remaining balance. The remaining balance is due the Wednesday prior to the week that your child attends camp. We offer a 2nd child discount of \$10/week for weekly camp enrollments, please note there is not a 2nd child discount available for daily rates.

Daily registration must be complete the Wednesday prior to the week of attending camp.

Over \$800 in Savings If You Choose a Camp Payment Plan Option!

Payment plans are non-refundable, each package offers a different payment option. The payment plans offer a 2nd child discount of \$100, the discount will be applied based on the plan that you choose. For example if you choose option 1 you will pay \$1,050 for child 1 and you will pay \$950 for child 2 at time of registration.
