Space is limited to 30 children during each swim time.

Frequently Asked Questions

Do I need to register my entire family?

- No, only register the children participating in the Egg Hunt. Ages 6 month – 12 years.

Do parents/guardians need to be in the pool?

- Parents/guardians only need to be in the pool if their child is ages 6 or under (this includes our Splash Area). Parents/guardians are encouraged to swim with their children during the Family Swim Time.

How will the egg hunt take place?

- We will release the eggs in the pool prior to the start. It does not matter how many eggs the child “finds” as everyone leaves with a gift bag.
- We will have some special “shiny” eggs that if found those children will receive an extra prize. We will only honor finding 1 shiny egg per child.
- Participants will be given 15 minutes to find the eggs and then we ask that they turn them in at that point. This will allow us to sanitize the eggs for the next egg hunt.

What do we need to bring?

- **Come dressed & ready to swim to eliminate overcrowding in the locker room. Make sure you have towels, as we no longer offer them. Bring a basket or bag to collect the eggs!**

Maintaining a Healthy Environment:

- All participants and/or family members should NOT attend the Easter Egg Hunt or enter the building if they are feeling ill, have a fever or had a fever in the last 72 hours or are experiencing any of the following: symptoms:
 - Chills
 - Muscle pain
 - Sore throat
 - Shortness of breath
 - New loss of taste or smell
 - Vomiting
 - Diarrhea

Please stay home if not feeling well and contact YMCA by phone at 608-365-2261 to cancel your registration.

If anyone in a participants household tests positive for COVID-19, the YMCA must be notified immediately. The participant will not be able to participate in the Egg Hunt and/or other programs until the YMCA has a release order from his/her physician.

Please stay home if the participant or anyone else in the household has been exposed to COVID-19, and contact the YMCA.
